Wine Analysis

In the Vineyard

Selected primarily from one vineyard of Sangiovese in Charleston and one Pinot Noir vineyard in Gumeracha. The Sangiovese vineyard ripened evenly and slowly to produce elegant fresh fruit characters with lively natural acidity while the Pinot Noir was added to complement the cherry and strawberry characters with hints of savouriness.

In the Winery

Crushed, destemmed and chilled to air bag press as a blend of both varieties, the grapes were then pressed within the hour due to high colour from the 2015 vintage. The juice was then fined and settled for 72 hours until clear and was then racked for ferment. The juice was inoculated with a fruit enhancing yeast and fermented at cool temperatures to preserve the natural fresh fruit characters. The wine was bottled early to preserve the delicate fresh fruit characters.

In the Glass

Colour

Vibrant pink rose with highlighted hues of purple, brilliant clarity.

Bouquet

Lifted aromas of strawberry sherbert, fresh blueberries and rose petals with a hint of strawberries and cream.

Palate

Lively fresh fruits of ripe strawberries and raspberries fill the palate with a lingering note of strawberries and cream.

Balanced acidity and a subtle savoury spice finish balance with the gentle sweetness and lingering palate of fresh fruit.

Persistent and intense in flavour – ideally suited for a spring or summer lazy afternoon.
