Innocence

2019 Pinot Noir Rosé

Adelaide Hills

VINEYARD

Sourced primarily from a single vineyard in Kuitpo. The block is from a cool slight planted to clone D4V2 on a western slope and allows great acid retention with pretty florals and fresh strawberry notes. A small portion of Sangiovese Free run was added to enhance the raspberry fruit character.

WINERY

The block was Machine picked in the early hours of the morning and destemmed but not crushed to press, the free run cut was made at 550L/tonne to retain the delicate fruit characters and attain very soft tannin extraction. The pressings portion wasn't used in the final blend. The Free run portions were fermented with a varietal enhancing yeast to preserve and enhance the varietal character of Pinot Noir. Post ferment a small amount of SO₂ was added and the parcel left on lees for 4 months to build complexity and richness on the palate.

COLOUR

Salmon pink blush with brilliant clarity.

BOUQUET

Complex nose of wild strawberry, boiled raspberry lollies, spring blossoms and new season nectarines, complexing hints of freshly baked brioche.

PALATE

The palate has good fruit intensity with trueness of fruit displaying raspberry and strawberry notes with subtle floral notes, balanced acidity lifts the delicate white florals and balances the fresh raspberry notes finishing with a refreshing strawberries and cream character. Voluptuous palate with intensity, drive and length with a subtle hint of freshly baked sourdough on the finish.
